ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Illinois Graphic Communications Scholarship Consortium (IGCSC) is made up of the Great Lakes Graphics Association, the past Calumet Ben Franklin Club and the Graphic Communications Guild, and is a subcommittee of GLGA's Illinois Education Task Force formerly headed by Chairman Dan Wilson, Professor - Coordinator of Graphic Communications, Department of Technology at Illinois State University.

The scholarships are intended for students in Illinois seeking continuing education in the graphic communications field. Candidates must be enrolled in a graphic communications program or have been accepted into a program.

Profits received from the Chicagoland Printers Scholarship Golf Outing, the Great Lakes Graphics Association Education Foundation and the remaining funds of the past Calumet Ben Franklin Club fund these Illinois scholarships. Since the inaugural golf outing in 2013, the participating organizations have awarded 71 scholarships totaling more than \$115,000.

This year the Education Committee elected to move funds and administration from the Consortium to the Print and Graphics Scholarship Foundation. PGSF is a not-for-profit, private industry directed organization that dispenses technical school, undergraduate and graduate fellowship assistance to men and women interested in a career in the graphic communications field. The Illinois Consortium award rules will remain the same with the foundation, and a representative from Illinois will serve on the PGSF board of directors.
