## ABOUT THE ILLINOIS GRAPHIC COMMUNICATIONS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

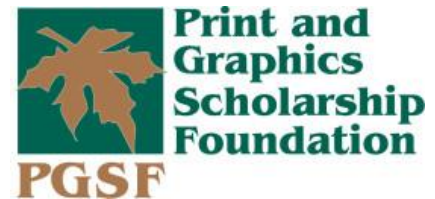
The Illinois Graphic Communications Scholarship Program was launched by the Illinois Graphic Communications Scholarship Consortium (IGCSC), whose members represented the Great Lakes Graphics Association, the Graphic Communications Guild, and the former Calumet Ben Franklin Club.

Starting in 2013 these three associations joined together to host the Chicagoland Printers Scholarship Golf Outing, and it continues to be co-hosted by the Graphic Communications Guild and the Great Lakes Graphics Association. The proceeds from the outing support scholarships for deserving students in Illinois who are seeking continuing education in the graphic communications field. **Since our inaugural golf outing, 86 scholarships totaling more than \$144,500 have been awarded.**
